2016-2017 Home School Programs Tuition Schedule & Application Process

To better serve all Rancho students, Rancho Christian School offers two Home School programs from which interested families may choose. Each offers different fees and benefits, so please read the following information carefully before applying.

Rancho Christian Hybrid Program (6-12 grades only)

This program is designed for students interested in benefiting from the Rancho experience. In many cases, the Hybrid program is an ideal first step as a student transitions from a Home School experience to a full Day School one.

Students in the Hybrid program may participate in RCS school activities, such as robotics, athletics, and arts. This includes promotions and graduations. Additional fees apply for these activities; see school administration, athletic coaches, or program directors for more details on estimated fees.

Requirements/Benefits:

Students in the RCHS Hybrid program are required to take a minimum of two (2) year-long courses **on campus** (or the equivalent; e.g. two semester courses would equate to one year-long course) each year.

At least one course must be a Bible Course (MS) or Theology & Biblical Studies (HS).

Students are required to attend Chapel on the days they are on campus for class.

Participation in Independent PE or on sports teams, and the accompanying Strength and Conditioning classes, do not count when selecting two courses. Rather, RCHS Hybrid students may participate in Independent PE or on sports teams and in Strength and Conditioning classes as if they are full-time students (sports participation fees still apply).

Elective course enrollment is subject to availability.

This program is NOT available to any student who has attended Rancho as a Full-Time Day student.

Rancho Christian Academy Program (K-12 grades)

This program is designed for Home School families looking for administrative assistance with an experienced academic advisor.

Requirements/Benefits:

Academy students may not participate in any additional classroom benefits (fieldtrips, picture day, etc) or afterschool activities (athletics, arts, etc).

K-5 students taking a class that has performance elements, may participate in those activities. K-5 courses on campus may be taken as space allows in the following areas: Computers, Choir, Band and Physical Education.

6-12 Academy students are not eligible to take any courses on campus.

Academy students are automatically members of ACSI. Academy students may participate in any ACSI activities including but not limited to speech meet, spelling bee, art show, math Olympics, etc.)

Academy students are also responsible for their own standardized testing.

Textbooks choices are made with the assistance of academic advisors but shall be purchased by families, not the program.

High School Academy students may receive Common Application services as needed.

To apply:

All Hybrid and Academy students must go through the application process before enrolling, supplying academic and behavioral records and interviewing with a member of the admissions/administrative team.

Application Fee: \$100 (non-refundable)

Records: An academic advisor must review all past course work with other institutions, homeschool or otherwise. All additional courses completed outside of Rancho must also be reviewed and accepted by a Rancho Academic Advisor in order to be considered for any promotion or graduation participation.

Interview: After you complete the online application, you will be contacted by our Admissions Office to schedule an interview.

To enroll:

Once accepted or if student is returning, they must complete the online enrollment process.

Enrollment Fee: \$250 (prior to and including April 15th) \$350 (after April 15th)

Online Enrollment: After your application is approved, the admissions office will send you enrollment instructions. Returning students may visit their RenWeb account for re-enrollment instructions.

Tuition & Payments

Payments: Please see attached information regarding tuition rates and FACTS Tuition Payment Services. All students in both the Hybrid and Academy Programs must use FACTS Online Payment Services.

Tuition Assistance: Unfortunately, Rancho Christian Hybrid and Academy students are not eligible for tuition assistance.

Withdrawal: Families are responsible for the **entire semester's tuition**, whether or not your child is in attendance. This includes student expulsions. Withdrawal notices received after **May 1, 2016** will be responsible for the full first semester tuition. Withdrawal notices received after **November 2, 2016** will be responsible for the full second semester tuition.
